February 8/9 – The Presentation of the Lord – Year C

1st Reading: Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8 (75C) — Isaiah received a call from the Lord. With a burning coal his lips were cleansed and his sin removed. When the Lord asked for a messenger, Isaiah replied, "Here I am, send me!"

<u>2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 or 15:3-8, 11</u> – Paul urged everyone to remain faithful to the gospel he preached, namely, that Christ died for sin and rose again. This "least of the apostles" received the Lord's blessings.
