## March 8/9 - First Sunday of Lent - Year C

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 26:4-10 (24C) — Moses told the story of the Israelites: The LORD God led them from bondage to freedom. This story should always be recalled before offering gifts to God. The people of God can rejoice over the many good things the Lord has given them.

<u>2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Romans 10:8-13</u> — God's word is on your lips and in your heart. If you proclaim with yours lips that Jesus is Lord and believe it in your heart, you will be saved. "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
