## <u> March 29/30 – Fourth Sunday of Lent – Year C</u>

1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Joshua 5:9a, 10-12 (33C) – God delivered Israel from Egypt. All the people celebrated Passover with unleavened cakes and parched grain in their new land, the promised land flowing with milk and honey.

<u>2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21</u> — We are ambassadors for Christ and ministers of reconciliation to one another. We must all be reconciled to God so that we might "become the righteousness of God in him."
