April 26/27 - Second Sunday of Easter - Year C

1st Reading: Acts of the Apostles 5:12-16 (45C) – Through the work of the apostles, many signs and wonders took place among the people. People in great numbers became believers, and many sick people were cured.

2nd Reading: Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19 — The author of Revelation had a vision of seven gold lampstands. Among the lampstands was one like a son of man.

Gospel: John 20:19-31 — One of the Twelve, Thomas, was absent when the risen Lord first appeared to the others. Later, when Thomas was with them, Jesus came and said, "Bring your hand and put it into my side, and... believe." Thomas cried, "My Lord and my God!"
