This is part of a multi-year, national movement to revive and foster Eucharistic devotion in dioceses, parishes, and the hearts of the faithful. In keeping with this vision, especially to emphasize whole-family faith formation, this year we will join our diocesan Eucharistic Congress with our annual CYC Convention.

The CYC Board is working diligently to create a high-impact youth track for the weekend, including a “sneak peek” for high school youth on Friday night, inspiring youth-focused keynotes, and, as always, a dance on Saturday night.

We will also provide childcare for elementary-aged youth during the weekend so that adults can participate fully.

Music for Lent and Easter

At St. Ann, music selected for mass or any service goes through a selection process before we use it to ensure it is best for both the Church and our parish. “Full, conscious, active participation” means **everyone** should be participating in the mass through singing, spoken prayers, etc. As a result, our music serves us with:

Prelude: Provides quiet, meditative, reflective time for you to prepare for mass by praying, looking at the readings, etc. For now, it will continue to end by playing all the hymns for the mass so that you are familiar with them and ready to sing along.

Hymns: Hymns selected are **singable** by the average person/congregation and are meant to be sung by everyone. Hymn singing in the Catholic church is a group activity (not a solo event), and our hymns sound so much better when everyone is singing along!

To help you out, we **transpose** all sung music into lower keys so that everyone can sing along. **Cantors cue you** (raise their arm) when it is time to sing. **Cantors sing the melody only** so it is easier to sing along with. The **organist plays the melody** in a more dominant registration (or octaves on the piano) so it is easier to sing along. Most hymns have **recognizable melodies** so they are easier to sing (for example, Beethoven's *Ode to Joy* is used for 4 hymns!) So, please help make a joyful noise unto the Lord!

Liturgically appropriate: Music selected reflects the message from the readings and the season.

To reflect the season of Lent, our hymns are #463 *From Ashes to the Living Font*, #947 *Draw Near and Take the Body of the Lord*, and #461 *Lord, Who Throughout These 40 Days*.

Lent

Question:

Lent always seems to help me renew my relationship with God and strengthen my religious practice. Do you have any suggestions as to what I could do to achieve that the rest of the year?

Answer:

The obvious answer may seem to be to do whatever you do during Lent all year round. But part of the power of Lent is that we focus as a community on renewing our faith and preparing for Easter. Our Lenten practices have a purpose and a goal. Therein lies the secret. When we focus our efforts on one virtue, or try to change one bad habit, or seek to deepen our understanding of one aspect of faith, we focus our efforts and give our full attention to what we are trying to accomplish. We tend to be more successful achieving our goals. More importantly, it has a ripple effect in our lives: one thing changes or is added to the spiritual mix of our lives and many aspects are changed.

All too often we leave our spiritual growth to chance and the practice of faith to habit, and then wonder why we have no sense of growth or progress. Think of it in terms of exercise. We walk, lift weights, bend and stretch to attain the maximum benefit from what we do. In addition, to keep those benefits, we eat healthful food and get enough vitamins and rest. Spirituality requires the same kind of attention: we pray, fast, read the Bible, receive sacraments, and do charitable work to maximize the benefits of practicing faith. 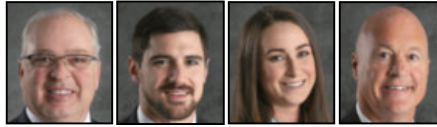

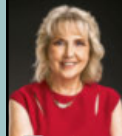

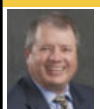
