



I was busy. So busy that I just wasn't going to have time to donate to my parish's annual Thanksgiving food drive. Then, three days before the holiday, I received an email from the parish stating that, while we typically deliver about 120 boxes, we were only at about 50. That got my attention! So I bought some canned goods on the way home and took them to church, an investment of less than \$15 and 15 minutes. Apparently, the email had the same effect on others—we ended up with more than 160 boxes.

It's easy to think that what we do is so small that it won't be missed if we take a pass. But the amount of our yeast isn't the point. What matters is that we mix it into the lives of others-and have faith that the Lord will take care of the leavening. Melanie Rigney


