



Music Ministry

YOU are our main music makers at mass! We are all called to "full, active, conscious participation" within the mass. It is amazing how all of our voices (yes, every voice) blend together and create powerful and motivating music during the mass. Even if you think you have a poor voice, remember it is the voice God gave you, so give it back to Him through your singing and prayers! It is so rewarding and fun to sing and play at mass when we can hear you singing along. Thank you!

Did you know that our St. Ann music program is *saving the parish about \$4,000 per year* and helping our environment by no longer using the annual disposable worship books we used to use? Our red hymnals, (for which we received a grant last year) are designed to last multiple years. Please treat them at least as well or better as you would any quality library book. Do not bending the page corners or mark in them. Use the bookmarks as they become available to indicate the readings and hymns. Thank you!

There are many opportunities for you to participate in our music programs. We would love to have more programs; ultimately, how much we can do is dependent upon volunteers:

Adults: Our adults are the backbone of all of our music.

- Our cantors and keyboardists are servant leaders, not performers, and serve the church through music. We are all volunteers and enjoy singing and playing. Our rehearsals are on Wednesdays from 6:30pm-7:15pm. You don't need to be a trained concert artist to help us just use the talent God gave you!
- If you are willing to help and have a busy schedule, then consider helping out once a month or even once a year. Anything helps and is much appreciated.
- All people in the music ministry in this diocese are required to take the VIRTUS training and remain active in it.
- Volunteer to help with our music programs with our youth. Again, we can do so much more if we have the volunteers.

Youth: Our youth have many opportunities during the year to participate in one of our programs.

- The RSCM Voice for Life program is a structured program and incorporates basic music, church music and liturgy. This program is a commitment with expectations of good attendance, practice, sing/play for church, etc. It is preparing our next generation of musicians.
- There is the opportunity to learn to play instruments such as piano, organ (only for trained pianists), recorder, chimes, etc. Students are expected to play/sing for mass when ready.
- If your child is busy with lots of extra-curricular activities, there is still the opportunity to participate (with only a few rehearsals) in the Christmas Eve and Easter masses providing both the music and liturgical readings.
