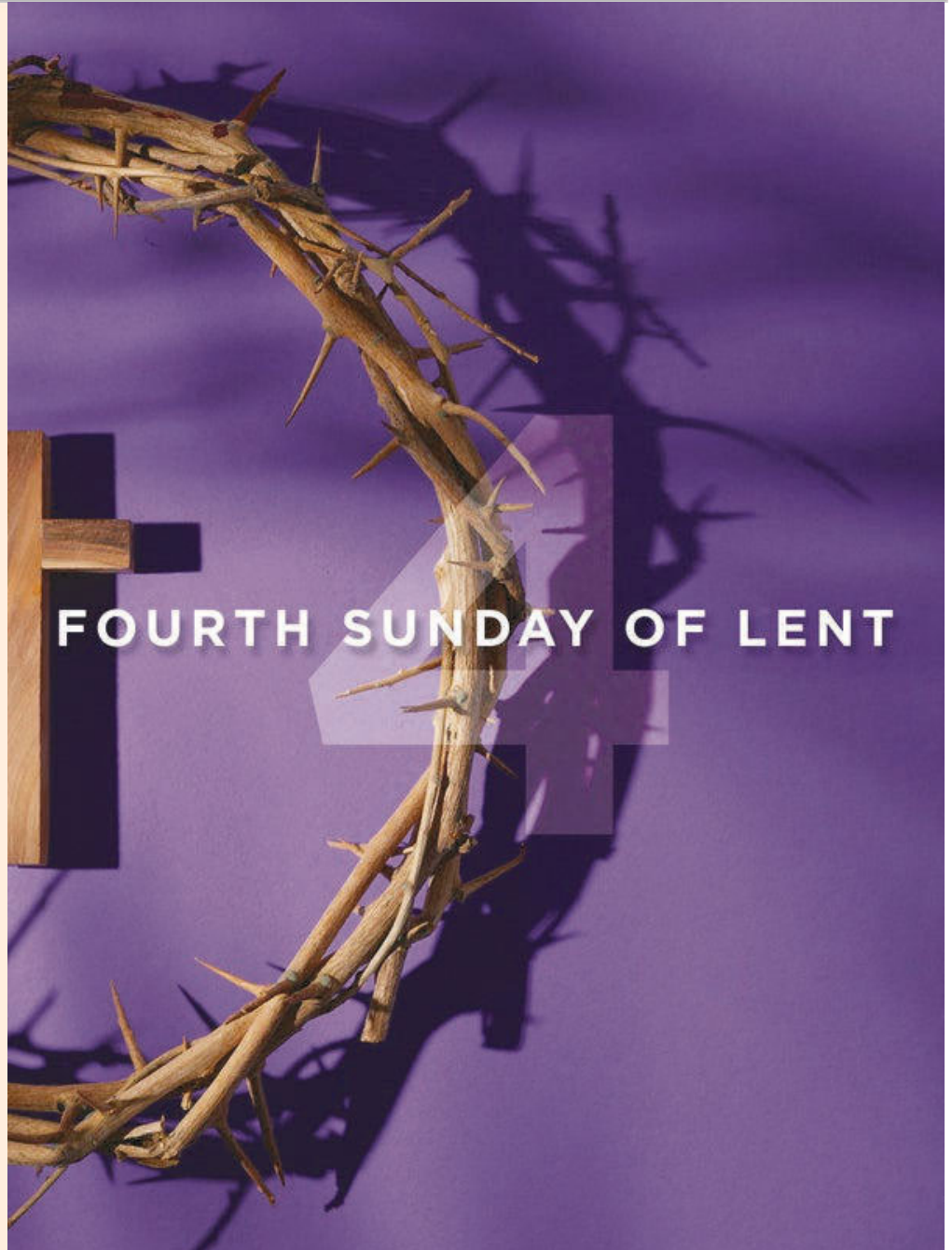

Butte Central 'Kentucky Derby' Annual Auction

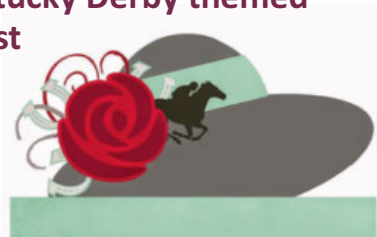

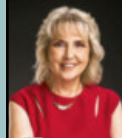
