

**PREP CLASS-**Our next baptism preparation class is Saturday, September 7 at 9 a.m. You must call to register for this class. Please call after August 21. If there is no answer, dial 121 for Vickie's ext. and leave a message.

**To Schedule a Baptism -** In order to baptize at St. Elizabeth's, the parents of the child should be registered members of St. Elizabeth's, or live within our boundaries. Parents please come to the office to schedule your child's baptism. You will need to bring in the baby's birth certificate, from the county, the godparents' confirmation certificates, if the godparents are married, a copy of their church marriage certificate and proof of Baptism prep classes for parents and godparents.

We do baptisms the 1<sup>ST</sup> & 2<sup>ND</sup> weekends of the month. Baptisms will be held on the 3RD weekend only if Spanish is requested.

The first person to come into the office with all necessary paperwork to register for a weekend will get to pick which day, Saturday or Sunday, for **all** baptisms that weekend.

You must register in the office, before the date of your child's baptism and you must have all paperwork!

#### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Apart from the period from Thanksgiving through Christmas, the summer is a favored time for family reunions. We trace family trees and recall our origins. Worship has a family tree as well, and the way we celebrate today has been influenced by various styles and customs through the centuries. We are Western Christians of the Latin Rite. By far, we are the most numerous Western Christians, but there are other ritual families as well. The Archdiocese of Milan in Italy follows the Ambrosian Rite. Toledo in Spain preserves the Mozarabic Rite and the Arab language, and Lyons in France is home to the Gallican Rite. Other liturgical families, such as the Celtic in Ireland and the Sarum in England, faded away after the Reformation. Until recent times, members of some ancient religious orders such as Carmelites and Trappists followed a pattern of Mass that varied slightly from the plan observed in Latin Rite parishes.

Isn't the Catholic Church the same everywhere? Not at all. It never has been! The existence of so many liturgical families in the West reminds us that unity, not uniformity, is what the Church seeks to achieve among her children. We are united in faith, but wonderfully diverse in rituals, ceremonies, languages, customs, and spirituality.

### Learning Points about the Eucharist


Recently, there has been some questions about the "power" of the Eucharist. In future weeks, I will take a moment to list 10 facts about the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Here are the first TWO points:

- 1) Reception of the Eucharist "fuses" our being with that of Christ. St. Cyril of Alexandria compares it to "when melted wax is fused to other wax". Our journey is for Christ to "abide in him and He in us". The Eucharist is a means to which this can happen.
- 2) The Eucharist destroys VENIAL SIN. When we receive the Eucharist, we are united with Christ who BURNS away the vestiges of venial sins and leaves us cleansed.
