- 4. If you have underlying conditions and need to stay isolated*
- 5. If you are over 65 ...*

TRASH IN CATHOLIC CHARITIES

TRAILER

It's incredible! It's unbelievable! Some of our neighbors place “trash” in our Catholic Charities trailer – items that are broken, badly soiled, unusable. **Catholic Charities does NOT accept mattresses, infant car seats, electronic devices like TVs or old computers, broken and distressed furniture.** If it doesn't work, THROW IT AWAY, don't put it in the trailer. Catholic Charities has to place 50% of so-called “donations” in their dumpster (at considerable cost) which is very inconsiderate. As to donating things; how about washing them first? Some people donate dirty pots, pans, clothing and furniture!!! Please help us out, don't burden us with your garbage.

BAPTISM

PREP CLASS- Our next class will be Tuesday, June 1, 6:30 PM, in the Hall, to accommodate social distancing. Please call after May 20 to register. If no answer dial extension 121 and leave a message.

To Schedule a Baptism - In order to baptize at St. Elizabeth's, the parents of the child should be registered members of St. Elizabeth's, or live within our boundaries. Parents please come to the office to schedule your child's baptism. You will need to bring in **the baby's birth certificate from the county, the godparents' confirmation certificates, if the godparents are married a copy of their church marriage certificate and proof of Baptism prep classes for parents and godparents.**

We do baptisms the 1ST & 2ND weekends of the month. Baptisms will be held on the 3RD weekend **only if Spanish is requested.**

The first person to come into the office with all necessary paperwork to register for a weekend will get to pick which day, Saturday or Sunday, for **all** baptisms that weekend.

You must register in the office before the date of your child's baptism and you must have all paperwork!
