

Working to Reduce Poverty in America.

THANK YOU to all of you supporting Catholic Charities' ministry to the many families and individuals seeking assistance during a difficult time in their lives.

The two caseworkers at Catholic Charities wear many hats on a daily basis. They may be sitting behind a desk one-minute tending to a client and when finished are off to the dock to help unload donated food or furniture.

Our caseworkers see many clients on a daily basis and must make decisions that not only affect the person sitting in front of them but an entire family. They understand that asking for help is hard. Many of our clients state they are embarrassed they are asking for help. Many say asking for help is both humbling and humiliating as they are not able to resolve their crisis. Sometimes this hurt turns into anger directed at the caseworker.

The caseworkers understand that living in poverty is not a defect. They comfort clients and guide them through the process of learning financial literacy tools so they do not find themselves in these types of situations in the future. They assure the clients they will be available to them as they develop their skills to manage their household budgets. All clients are treated with respect and dignity. Recently, an elderly gentleman was interviewed for assistance. He had walked many miles to Catholic Charities to

assistance. He had walked many miles to Catholic Charities to ask for help with his current situation. As he explained to the caseworker why he was there, tears started streaming down his face. He stated he had always worked, had never before asked anyone for help, and was deeply ashamed to find himself asking for help. He had recently lost his job and was waiting for unemployment benefits until he could find another job.

When our caseworker called the landlord to see what we could do to help, the landlord informed her that she would not allow the client to continue to live there. There would be many more calls to find a solution to this gentlemen's crisis. Many of the client's crisis can be stabilized immediately but sometimes no matter how much they try, there is not an immediate workable solution. These cases weigh heavily in their hearts.

Our caseworkers invite you to support them in prayer as they tend to the most vulnerable. Our goal is always to try to send clients out with a smile on their face knowing there is hope for a better tomorrow.
