Working to Reduce Poverty in America.

What does it mean to volunteer at Catholic Charities Odessa? Some middle schoolers from St. Mary's Central Catholic School were asked and here are their responses:

"I like Catholic Charities because I like helping and restocking food." - *Richard* "The reason I most enjoy helping at Catholic Charities is that I know my time is going to help people in need."  
 - *Jake* "I like to go to Catholic Charities because it feels good to give back to the community with my friends. It makes me happy."  
 - *Jocelyn* "I like to go to Catholic Charities because it makes me feel good about the deeds I have done and to give back to my community"  
 - *Mason* "I like going to Catholic charities because I like helping out people who might need supplies that they might be unable to get on their own. It's fun to spend time with my friends and teachers who feel the same way too."  
 - *Violet* "To see my friends, to help lift heavy stuff."  
 - *Noah* "I like going to Catholic Charities because I see my grandma also working in the pantry, and I like helping people too I see my grandma helping the people that don't have anything and that are running out of food. I enjoy making people feel like God listened to their prayers and that I was sent to help people out."  
 - *Anna*

Their teacher also responded: "I started out volunteering at Catholic Charities six years ago by taking middle schoolers from St. Mary's Central Catholic school occasionally during the school year. During COVID we started going once a month because they really needed volunteers and the students really liked helping out. The past couple of summers we have been volunteering once a week for 3 hours. We work hard mostly in the food pantry stocking shelves, unloading pallets, making food boxes, sorting clothes, and anything else that needs to be done. But it's work for the Lord. It's giving to others all that we have been blessed with. The students don't complain and ask what else needs to be done. I know parents can't believe this but it's true. We love the other workers there. They are so friendly and helpful. They don't mind that they are giggly middle schoolers. Why do I volunteer? Even if I didn't have students I would volunteer. I love it and it's the right thing to do. As the letter of St. James says: "If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well, but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it? So also, faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead.'" This is a time for faith demonstrated by good works. But just as importantly, because I'm a teacher of these young people I need to model what it means to be a good Catholic Christian. As stated by the U.S. Catholic Bishops in their position statement on poverty, A Place at the Table, on November 13, 2002.

"Preaching, education, and formation in our communities of faith must reflect the Church's option for the poor and vulnerable. Through preaching, education, and religious formation, we reflect and pass on to others the beliefs we share as followers of Jesus. If they are to be true to the demands of discipleship, then homilies, faith formation programs, schools, universities, and seminaries must reflect Christ's concern for those in need. They should also affirm our Church's teaching about the obligation to serve others, to overcome structures of sin, and to work for greater justice in the world. We urge those who preach and those who teach to do more to consistently share—in our parishes, schools, universities, and seminaries—the call to serve and to promote justice for those who are poor."
