Introduction of 2025-2026 Pastoral Plan July 1, 2025

Dear friends in Christ,

Now that we have concluded the three-year period of the National Eucharistic Revival (2022- 2025), we have created a new diocesan pastoral plan for the Diocese of San Angelo. This plan provides a vision and priorities for our ministries for the next three years, from the summer of 2025 through the summer of 2028.

The title of our 2025-2028 pastoral plan is "Called to Flourish: Growing into Our Full Potential." Over the past several months, we have consulted the members of our Catholic Church around the diocese to determine the needs and the hopes of the people of God in West Texas. We distributed surveys, held public listening sessions at different locations around the diocese, met with smaller focus groups, and held a diocesan leadership summit. The feedback we received

For the next three years, the four main pastoral priorities in our diocese will be the following:

- Faith Formation
- Spiritual Renewal
- Vocation Vision
- Effective Communication

There are, of course, many other areas in the ministry of the Church that are not specifically mentioned in this plan. This does not mean that those other areas are unimportant. The goals of this plan represent areas where we will intentionally focus particular energy for the next three years, seeking to grow into our full potential as a local Church.

I encourage all Catholics in the Diocese of San Angelo to read the entire eleven-page Pastoral Plan document, "Called to Flourish: Growing into Our Full Potential," on the diocesan website at www.sanangelodiocese.org. Over the next three years, our parishes and diocesan ministries will seek to carry out the initiatives for each year of this plan, to increase the effectiveness of our response to the mission of Christ for our Church.

Sister Christina Chávez is a Sister with the Congregation of Divine Providence of San Antonio, TX. She is from the Diocese of San Angelo and graduated from Crane High School. Though she is the product of a devout Catholic family that is active in the local parish, she did not have the religious life on her radar as an option for her future. She grew up attending faith formation classes for her Sacraments and continued until high school graduation. In college at Texas Tech University, she participated in the Catholic Student Association of her campus, eventually joining in on the Raider Awakening retreat. Only then did the thought of "becoming a nun" begin to surface and she didn't believe that this was something a person could do in today's world. She was unfamiliar with the religious life and had only an impression from stereotypes in movies or on TV so she didn't initially attempt to pursue the calling, Rather, the calling pursued her and she found the CDP Sisters by picking up an information card at St. Stephen's parish in Midland. That's when her formation for religious life began (in 2013) and she professed her First Vows in 2018. The period after first vows is sometimes referred to as "temporary profession" because the Sister's vows are said for one year at a time and will expire at the end of that year. This means every year, the Sister is living her yows and will also evaluate whether or not she feels called to continue in the religious life and will make a request to renew her vows. Her community is also discerning whether she is a good fit for them as well. After several years in temporary profession, a Sister is able to make her permanent, life-long commitment with her "perpetual profession" also known as "final vows" to which she professes to live for the rest of her life. After twelve years in this formation process, this is the step which Sister Christina will be taking this summer. Sister Christina has worked for the Diocese of San Angelo for two years as the campus minister serving college students in Odessa & Midland. She enjoys serving young adults in this critical time in their lives. She strives to create welcoming spaces where students are encouraged to build community and grow in faith.

Sister Christina will have her Mass of Perpetual Profession on July 26, 2025 in San Antonio, TX. We will also host a Mass of Thanksgiving and reception for her and family at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton on August 23, 2025.






