On the last Sunday of each liturgical year (November 20, 2022), the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

El Papa Pío XI instituyó esta fiesta en 1925 para responder al creciente secularismo y ateísmo. 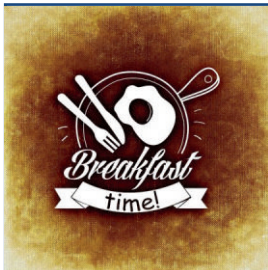

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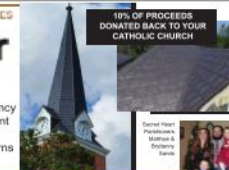
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
