

Corpus et Sanguinus Christi Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Corpus et Sanguinus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ) is a Eucharistic solemnity, or better, the solemn commemoration of the institution of that Sacrament. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, Who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave to the Church her greatest treasure. Holy Thursday, assuredly, marks the anniversary of the institution, but the commemoration of the Lord's passion that very night suppresses the rejoicing proper to the occasion. Today's observance, therefore, accents the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday. The Church encourages the faithful to receive Holy Communion under both species.
