



Reconciliation: Before or after Mass or by appointment.
Marriage: Nine months notice; marriage pep required.
Anointing of the Sick: Please let us know when someone is seriously ill, has a prolonged illness or is to have surgery. This sacrament celebrates the healing of mind and body and the forgiveness of sins.
Catholic Funeral Rites: When a death occurs in your family, please call the Parish Office and we will assist you in making the necessary liturgical arrangements.
