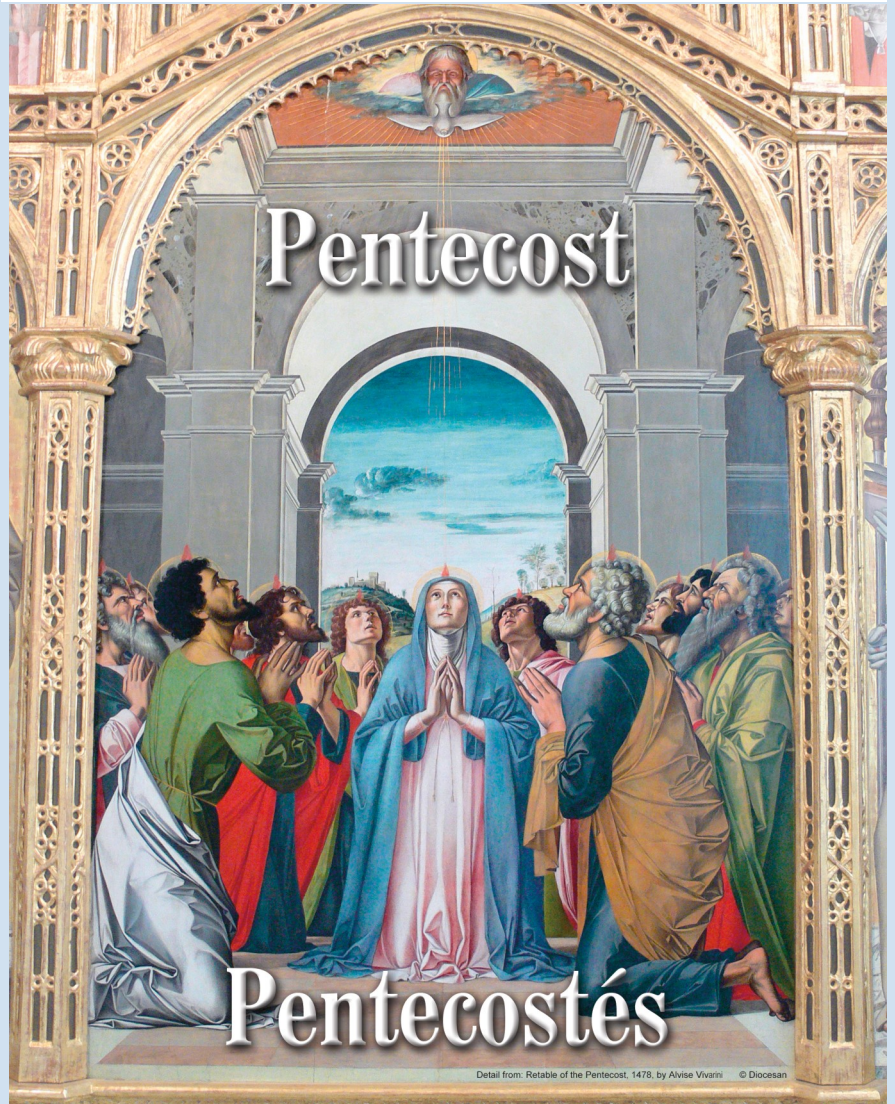

Under direction from the Archdiocese of Atlanta, public masses will soon resume.

Space in the church for masses will be extremely limited in Phase 1 as all attendees must follow CDC guidelines, including social distancing and the use of masks. To maintain social distancing in the sanctuary, only one family unit will be in each pew. Mass captains will open the doors and seat each family unit according to the guidelines. The church will fill from the front to the back. For now, we will sit where directed as opposed to choosing our seats. When the available pews are filled, that will be the maximum allowed for each mass.

The elderly or those with underlying conditions should stay home. Father Carlos will continue to livestream masses on Facebook in the evening. In the next few weeks, we will have video equipment installed in the church to allow all masses to be livestreamed.

Please be patient as the situation is ever-changing and evolving. This is the beginning and we will continue to update you on a regular basis as changes are implemented. Our goal is to allow as many as possible to celebrate mass, receive the Eucharist, and to offer personal prayer time.

Remember that Archbishop Hartmayer has given dispensation to the faithful in the Archdiocese for the obligation to attend Sunday mass through the end of June.

Returning to normal will require patience and the understanding that a little sacrifice now will lead us to a quicker return to the celebration of Mass as we once knew it.

2nd Annual Golf Tournament sponsored by the Knights DATE CHANGE!

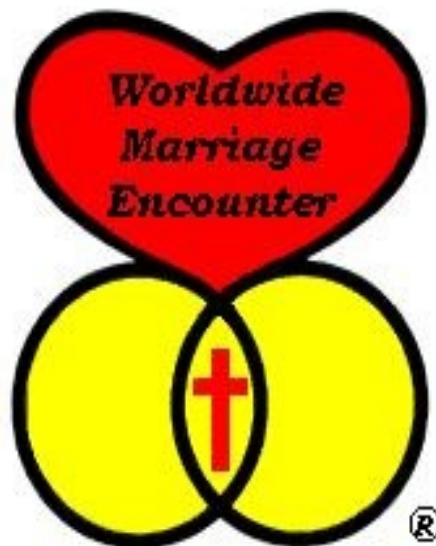
