

OUR FLEA MARKET Closing Down

For many years, the wonderful Parishioners of Good Samaritan Church have supported our annual Flea Market. Thanks to everyone's efforts, many underprivileged people and our church have benefited.

Thanks to the Boys & Girls Club, we have been able to use their facility for storage at a very nominal price. However, they are soon to begin construction on their new club and have given us notice that we need to vacate our storage space by mid-April.

Because of this, the parish council, Knights of Columbus and St. Vincent de Paul had a discussion about the merits of continuing the annual Flea Market. The increase in cost, this year's uncertainty around COVID's impact on the willingness of volunteers to work this Fall and the fact that our core volunteer group is composed of some of our older retired parishioners drove the decision to end the event.

Faith, Hope and Charity has agreed to take much of the items already donated. Other charities will also be invited. The proceeds from items already sold will be equally divided among SVDP, KOC and the Youth Group.

We want to thank all of you who have so graciously given your time volunteering over the past 20 plus years and those who have donated items.

A special thank you goes out to Bob and Sue Hughes, who served as sponsors of the event this past year and a half. Also, our gratitude to Debi Slaughter for all of her great work in helping to sell items online.

A letter from Father Carlos:

Many times, people ask me why our church is not open. They say that stores and restaurants are open, that many of our members have been vaccinated, and other churches seem to be open, so why don't we have masses on Sunday in the church? Our church doors are open- we are blessed with many weekday opportunities to celebrate Mass and visit with the Lord. We have room for many to join us for morning or evening masses during the week. The Archbishop gave permission weekday masses can satisfy our Sunday obligation.

We have an intimate sanctuary to worship in and that determines how many of us are permitted to attend mass with social distancing. We can have about 50 people; we usually have 100-125 people for 9am and 11am, and 150 or more for the 1pm mass.

I do not want to turn people away or tell them that we are full, and that they cannot celebrate mass with us. The drive-in masses on Sunday allow us to share the mass with everyone who wants to come.

When the guidelines from the CDC and the Archdiocese change, what we are able to do will change.

Until then, we will continue to have drive-in masses on Sundays.

I am open to other ideas. I could celebrate another mass on Saturday at 7pm, or a Sunday morning at 7:30am in the church. We would need to have enough volunteers for the team of lectors, ushers, sacristans, and altar servers for this. If you have ideas, please contact me so we can talk about them.

Celebrating Sunday masses in the church with all the pews filled would make me happy, and I pray that we will be able to do that soon.
