

## A Community Project with our St Vincent de Paul Society

The Good Samaritan Conference of St. Vincent de Paul, in conjunction with other churches and faith based organizations of Gilmer County, has initiated discussion on the possibility/ feasibility of bringing a free mobile healthcare unit to Gilmer to serve our less fortunate friends. We held our first meeting in December and I am pleased to say we are moving forward with the concept. Bethesda Community Clinic has offered to join with us and will provide the mobile unit and much of the staffing. We will provide logistical and administrative support as well as locations for the unit.

Primary emphasis will be on physical checkups that are often delayed or ignored because of financial considerations. Basic pharmacy supplies are included which will enable an easy transition to the SVDP free pharmacy program.

Our group will meet again in January to continue the process and are looking now at a mid February start date. We will need some volunteers to help us perform the admin functions. Also, anyone trained in health care, MD, RN, LPN, CNA, etc, could greatly aid in assisting the Bethesda professionals.

Please prayerfully consider volunteering some of your time to help us, 4 hours once or twice a month, and pray for the success of this endeavor. It will be a great aid to the quality of life of our neighbors that do not have insurance paid healthcare readily available.
