

Monies collected during this second collection are combined and then divided among missionaries selected.

Our second collection next weekend, July 17-18, will be for our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society. They assist Gilmer residents in need with food and financial assistance.



There is very little time required to set up for Mass, one half hour before Mass, and 15 minutes after Mass. The sacristan makes sure that all vessels for worship are available, and arranges the Liturgical book, which are readings for the day. In addition, we prepare the cruets which hold the water and wine, fill the ciborium with hosts, replace candles, clean the vessels after Mass and set up for the next Mass. We try to make our church a visible sign of love and reverence toward God.
