

OUTREACH PRIEST

Rev. Robert E. Nee, LICSW, BCC

Father Robert E. Nee was born January 19, 1945, in Boston, Massachusetts, the third of six children. His journey toward priesthood began at Father Damien Seminary and St Mary's College (now University) in Minnesota with the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary Congregation. His theological studies were done in New Hampshire and Washington, D.C.

Fr Bob was ordained April 14, 1971, at St. Mary of the Angels Church in North Fairhaven, Massachusetts. There he spent his "rookie" years as a priest. He recalls those five formative years as an "enriching and enjoyable" experience with a great pastor-mentor and loving parish community. Father then served on the Provincial Council of the Sacred Hearts community, directed the Office of Justice and Peace and was engaged in a retreat program for young adults. During the summers he often traveled around the US speaking about the missionary work of the community and raising funds to support this ministry.

Following his service to the province, Fr Bob returned to parish work in the greater Boston area for some 25 years. In addition, after graduate studies, he provided child and family therapy among the immigrant community with Catholic Charities in Lawrence, Massachusetts. Among beloved patients, families and staff of Boston Children's Hospital he spent his final full-time ministry as Catholic Priest Chaplain. In his semi-retirement Fr. Bob is happy to provide ministry when helpful at local parishes and serves in the human service efforts of his town.

He is very pleased to again travel to parishes, this time on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach. "It is a joy to be carrying the good news of how Catholics of the United States can participate in the transforming work of the Church among our sisters and brothers in the majority world who are in far less economically privileged places than in our country."
