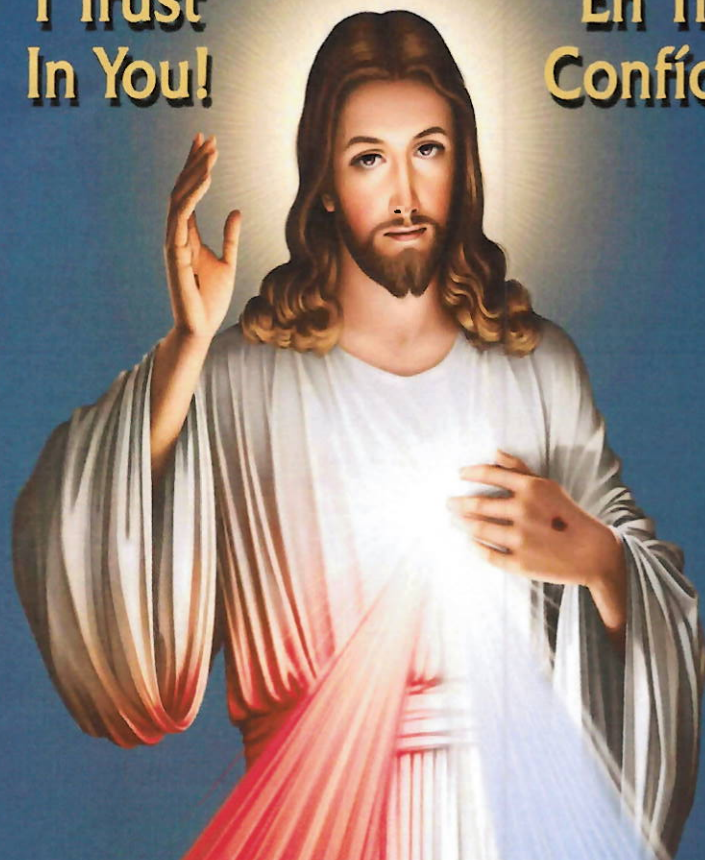

HOW TO PRAY THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

Optional Opening Prayers: (Use Rosary Beads)

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat 3 times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed

For each of the five decades (On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray)

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Concluding prayer (Repeat 3 times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

DIVINE MERCY APRIL 27—SAINT FAUSTINA

Shortly before the outbreak of World War II, a simple, young, uneducated Polish nun received a special calling. On the night of Sunday, February 22, 1931, while she was in her cell, Jesus appeared to Sister Faustina as the "King of Divine Mercy." He was wearing a white garment with red and pale rays emanating from his Sacred Heart. He would continue to appear and speak to her, and for four years St. Faustina recorded Jesus' words, her visions, and her own thoughts and prayers in a personal diary. Jesus gave St. Faustina a special mission, telling her, "I am sending you with My mercy to the people of the whole world. I do not want to punish mankind, but I desire to heal it, pressing it to My merciful Heart." He also said to her, "You are the secretary of My Mercy. I have chosen you for that office in this and the next life." In visions that followed, Jesus asked Saint Faustina to be His instrument for spreading the message of His Mercy to all the world. Oraciones iniciales opcionales: (Usar las cuentas del rosario)

Expiraste, Jesús, pero la fuente de vida brotó para las almas, y el océano de misericordia se abrió para el mundo entero. Oh Fuente de Vida, insondable Divina Misericordia, envuelve al mundo entero y derrámate sobre nosotros.

(Repetir 3 veces) ¡Oh Sangre y Agua, que brotaste del Corazón de Jesús como fuente de Misericordia para nosotros, en Ti confío!

Padrenuestro, Avemaria y Credo de los Apóstoles

Por cada una de las cinco decenas *(En cada cuenta del rosario, rezar)*

Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de tu Amado Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en expiación por nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.

(En cada una de las diez cuentas del Ave María, rezar)

Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.

Oración final (Repetir 3 veces)

Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.

Oración final opcional

Dios eterno, en quien la misericordia es infinita y el tesoro de la compasión inagotable, miranos con bondad y aumenta tu misericordia en nosotros, para que en los momentos difíciles no desesperemos ni nos desanimemos, sino que con gran confianza nos sometamos a tu santa voluntad, que es el Amor y la Misericordia mismos.

DIVINA MISERICORDIA, 27 DE ABRIL – SANTA FAUSTINA

Poco antes del estallido de la Segunda Guerra Mundial, una monja polaca, sencilla, joven e inculta, recibió una vocación especial. La noche del domingo 22 de febrero de 1931, mientras se encontraba en su celda, Jesús se le apareció a Sor Faustina como el «Rey de la Divina Misericordia». Vestía una túnica blanca con rayos rojos y pálidos que emanaban de su Sagrado Corazón. Continuó apareciéndose y hablándole, y durante cuatro años Santa Faustina registró las palabras de Jesús, sus visiones y sus propios pensamientos y oraciones en un diario personal.

Jesús le encomendó a Santa Faustina una misión especial, diciéndole: «Te envío con mi misericordia a los pueblos del mundo entero. No quiero castigar a la humanidad, sino sanarla, acercándola a mi Corazón misericordioso». También le dijo: «Eres la secretaria de mi Misericordia. Te he elegido para ese oficio en esta vida y en la otra». En visiones posteriores, Jesús le pidió a Santa Faustina que fuera su instrumento para difundir el mensaje de su Misericordia por todo el mundo. (Fuente: catholiccompany.com)
