The Capuchin Franciscans trace their heritage back 800 years to the little poor man of Assisi, whom history knows as perhaps the most clear imitator of Jesus Christ. St. Francis of Assisi followed Jesus' footsteps so closely and loved humanity and all creation so deeply that he is known as "the universal saint." He began the Franciscans – the Order of Friars Minor, literally "lesser brothers" – in 1209 and quickly gave them a Rule of Life, which the Pope orally approved that same year. Along with St. Clare of Assisi, Francis co-founded the Poor Clares and established the Secular Franciscan Order.

The Capuchin Franciscan Order began in 1528 as a renewal of the Order of Friars Minor. The friars of this reform movement wanted a life more focused on prayer and a stricter observance of poverty. These men were also fervent preachers of the Gospel and compassionate servants of the sick and suffering in their day. Attracting followers through their preaching, prayer, austerity, and service among the poor, the new reform movement grew rapidly and soon spread throughout all of Europe. The Capuchin Reform movement was given official approval by the Church in Pope Clement VII's Papal Bull, Religionis Zelus. The Capuchins were established as an independent order within the Franciscan Family.

The Capuchins truly captured the hearts of the people when the Black Plague struck Western Europe killing millions. While many of the clergy and religious fled the catastrophe, the Capuchins remained to care for the people. Over 2,000 friars died from the plague as Martyrs of Charity. Today, the Capuchins number about 10,500 friars worldwide. (capuchins.org)

De la Orden de los Frailes Menores Capuchinos:

Los franciscanos capuchinos remontan su herencia 800 años atrás al pequeño y pobre hombre de Asís, a quien la historia conoce como quizás el imitador más claro de Jesucristo. San Francisco de Asís siguió tan de cerca los pasos de Jesús y amó tanto a la humanidad y a toda la creación que se le conoce como "el santo universal". Fundó los franciscanos -la Orden de los Frailes Menores, literalmente "hermanos menores"- en 1209 y rápidamente les dio una Regla de Vida, que el Papa aprobó oralmente ese mismo año. Junto con Santa Clara de Asís, Francisco cofundó las Clarisas y estableció la Orden Franciscana Seglar.

La Orden Franciscana Capuchina comenzó en 1528 como una renovación de la Orden de los Frailes Menores. Los frailes de este movimiento reformista querían una vida más centrada en la oración y una observancia más estricta de la pobreza. Estos hombres fueron también fervientes predicadores del Evangelio y siervos compasivos de los enfermos y sufrientes en su tiempo. Atrayendo seguidores a través de su predicación, oración, austeridad y servicio entre los pobres, el nuevo movimiento reformista creció rápidamente y pronto se extendió por toda Europa. El movimiento de reforma capuchino recibió la aprobación oficial de la Iglesia en la bula papal del papa Clemente VII, Religionis Zelus. Los Capuchinos fueron establecidos como una orden independiente dentro de la Familia Franciscana.

Los capuchinos realmente capturaron los corazones de la gente cuando la peste negra azotó Europa occidental, matando a millones de personas. Mientras muchos de los clérigos y religiosos huyeron de la catástrofe, los capuchinos se quedaron para cuidar de la gente. Más de 2.000 frailes murieron a causa de la peste como Mártires de la Caridad. Hoy en día, los capuchinos suman unos 10.500 frailes en todo el mundo. (capuchins.org)
