## Spiritual Direction XVII

This week we begin hearing the “Bread of Life Discourse” from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. In the current state of affairs, and with all the tension between the Church and state, we need to hear more about what Jesus teaches us about the Eucharist. In 2007, Pope Benedict XVI wrote an Apostolic Exhortation, “Sacramentum Caritatis” concerning the Eucharist. The document that the U.S. Bishops are working on is strongly based on the 2007 document. It is the third section of that document that some have a problem with, that deals with how we are to live a Eucharistic life. Specifically, section (83) speaks of Eucharistic consistency or “a public witness to our faith.” Values taught by Jesus and the Church that are not negotiable. Those who live lives consist with the morals of Jesus and publicly put their faith on display are welcome. When any person examines their well formed conscience and finds that they are not living a life moving toward the path that Jesus walked should abstain from participating in the Eucharistic feast until they work to bring their lives into conformity to the teachings of Jesus and the Church.

## Father Logsdon Logging In...

I would like to start this week's bulletin article with some Scripture.

“Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vain glory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves.” -Philippians 2:3

“Therefore, encourage one another and build one another up, as indeed you do.” -1 Thessalonians 5:11

“Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.” -Ephesians 4:29

“Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another.” -Proverbs 27:17

This past two weeks we have had several opportunities to look at the good, the bad, and the path of Uniting in Heart at our individual parishes. Feedback has been mixed. People like the new priests, and there is a lot of energy. There have been consistent expressions of a lack of presence, which demonstrates a desire for sanctification. With the renaming of the Pastorate as the Holy Family, I thought we can start exploring what it means to be a family. The quotes above might be used in a holy hour to contemplate how we are to live as a family. People who attend the Saint Mary Church know that they are not Mary, but that we live through her intercession. Just as people who attend Immaculate Conception know that they are not sinless, but attempt to live like Mary and point others to Jesus. People who attend church Saint Joseph, may try to guide like the adopted father of Jesus, but they are not Joseph. People who attend Holy Trinity are called to emulate the overflowing love from the Trinity that flowed out and created everything, but they are not the Trinity. We are a family, or group of parishes, that are living and working together in eastern Indiana. We can become holy as we respect and encourage one another like a family. I pray that we come together for a United purpose so that Satan falls and we rise. United we stand and divided we fall.






