Father Logsdon Logging In...

Holy Scripture is poetry, and most of us are not familiar enough with how poetry works. Many times, our deepest emotions can be expressed in lyrical form, and we draw comfort from the way the words touch at things we associate with in the world. Today we do it with music, but poetry can still speak louder to our hearts. When a person spends time learning to read poetry, they can learn to express things in beautiful ways. God has done this in Holy Scripture! We are better able to understand our creator, the God of the whole universe, when we spend some time with His love poem to us.

This weekend is the second Scrutiny. Many of us are not familiar with this process when people are becoming Catholic. There are three scrutinies which highlight a growth in faith that people who are going to be baptized at the Easter vigil have undergone on their journey into the Church. The woman at the well, is about a desire for God. The man born blind is about how God helping us to see Him in the darkness of this world. Finally, the raising of Lazarus, is about how God brings us to life when we love Him completely. At the doors of all the churches there are pictures of all of the people who are coming into the church. Please take some time to pray for these individuals in their last couple weeks. This is when satan will do everything he can to distract and take these beautiful people off course.

As we are in Lent, we are offering extra opportunities for reconciliation at all four parishes. This week on Tuesday at Saint Joseph all evening after 6:00 pm Mass (a special Mass with an icon of St. Joseph). Fr. Marty and I will be available all evening. On Thursday, all morning, until noon and then from 6:00 pm until people are no longer coming. When there is a priest leading the stations of the cross, we are available after the stations. On Mondays during Lent from 6-7pm at I.C. During Holy Week, there will be other opportunities which will be announced. Also people can ask a priest when they might be available to hear a confession, it might not be immediately, but it is a part of our ministry in the care of souls.
