## Father Logsdon Logging In ...

“Habemus Papam”! Maybe we have heard this announcement this week, maybe not. When the Cardinal-electors have reached a 2/3 +1 decision, we will hear these historic words. With the advent of modern communication, there are not a whole lot of surprises. The secrecy surrounding the election of the new Pope allows the work of the Holy Spirit to take center stage. On the Feast of Pentecost, the Church was given life as the Holy Spirit guided (and continues to guide) our Church through the ages by giving us leaders that steer the people of God on the Arc of the Church on the narrow path to Heaven. If we do not have a Pope yet, our prayers will continue as we ask the Holy Spirit to inspire the Cardinals to elect the man that the Church needs, not who we want.

As we continue our Easter celebration, now the fourth week, the idea of continuing the celebration is hard in our western mentality. At the time of Jesus, and for many hundreds of years, celebrations lasted much longer because people had to travel long distances and many did not gather often. Easter lasts for 50 days, yet many of us have stopped greeting one another with Happy Easter! It seems like an easy way to evangelize if we just greet people with our faith. Another simple way to help other people grow in faith is to simply invite them back to Mass. Surveys have shown, the reason many people give for returning to the practice of the faith, is that someone invited them. Also, if you have not done so already, look at the photos of the people who came into the Church at the Easter Vigil and welcome them personally to the church.

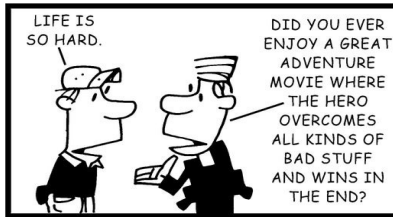

**COMMUNITY HELP CENTER**

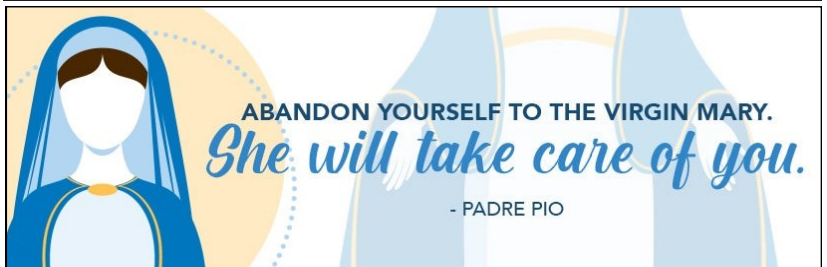

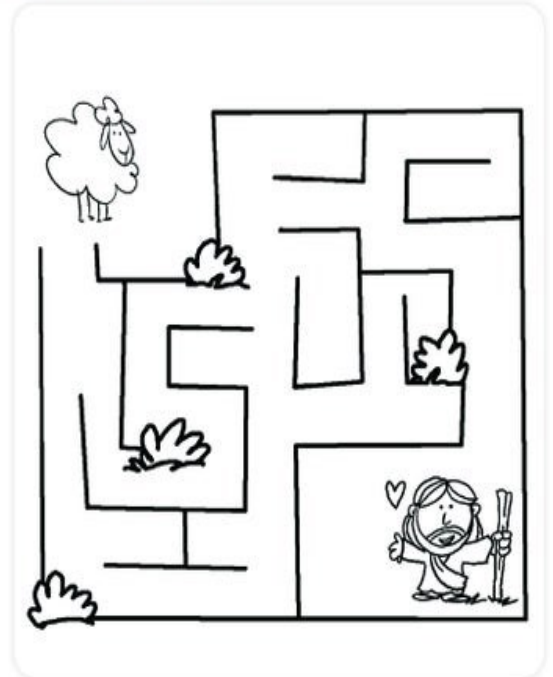
