Truth be told, there is always a bombardment of events that could occupy our limited time and energy. With the launch of AI, our preferences are being tracked and we should not be surprised when stories we are interested in come up on our news feed. One thing this can lead to is confirmation bias. When we hear/read everything that agrees with our way of thinking, we can begin to cement our beliefs about the world. I have news for people; the world is not always black and white. Our ability to hear what others are saying and to engage contrary opinions is being diminished by the polarization of social media and news outlets. I continue to pray that we may be open to what other people have to say and work to resolve our differences because in the end we are disciples of Jesus and are all working for the coming of the Kingdom of God.

This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. 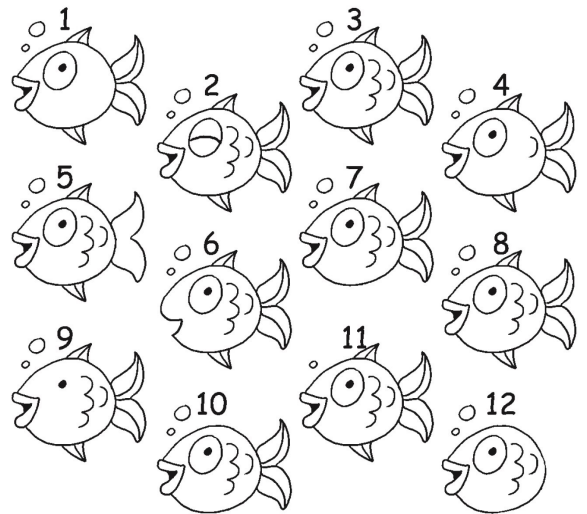
