## Father Logsdon Logging In ...

Our Faith family gathers, for the most part, on Sunday mornings. This time, especially just before and after Mass, may be one of the few times when people have time to speak to their priest. This is one of the reasons I really enjoy standing out front to greet people. Being a family requires us to have moments where we share stories and updates; it is what keeps us connected. Having such a large family, it can be difficult to hear and remember all that is said. If there is an immediate need, I will do all I can to address it. If there is something that needs to be scheduled for another time, I have some suggestions. Since I can forget, please either give me a note, or send me an e-mail reminder, that way I can follow up when there is not so much happening at once. I really do want to foster a sense of family among us, however, I need each person's help in remembering because we are a large family, and I am not getting any younger.

This weekend our Gospel is the story of Martha and Mary. Many people have interpreted this story to validate either a contemplative verses an active spiritual life. If we dig deeper, we can see that both are necessary, for growth in holiness. Jesus says that Mary has chosen the better part, implying that it is only a part of the whole and that Martha's part is important as well. The two parts are not opposed to one another, they foster the growth of the other.

I have been encouraging people to come to our town hall meetings So that we might have some more time together to discuss issues that effect our unity as a faith family. We have two more meetings. One at St. Joseph this week, and our final one at Holy Trinity the following week.
