Father Logsdon Logging in...

The readings from this 4th Sunday of Ordinary time seem to me to be pointing to a disposition of humility. If a person is aware of their pride, this is the solution. If a person is not aware of their pride, that might be the problem and this is the solution. No matter where we may stand on the continuum of pride and humility, it has always been the advise of the Holy Scriptures to constantly go back to the drawing board and re-evaluate. Like all virtues, humility is a middle point between pride and self loathing. In our continuing search for reaching into the virtuous life we can do no better then looking at this weekend's readings to evaluate our humility and recognize what it is we gain when we practice this foundational virtue.

Believe it or not, Lent is only 17 days away. It is not too soon to begin to plan your disciplines and goals for this Lenten season. As we evaluate our desire to grow in some aspect of holiness, may I make some suggestions? If we desire to make prayer a bigger part of our lives, schedule your prayer time and don't let anything bump that appointment with God (the most important person in your life). If you want to develop stronger willpower, give up something you normally enjoy everyday, tell your friends, and be humble enough to accept their correction. If you want to be more charitable, find someplace to volunteer and use your gifts for the good of society. These are just a few suggestions, and hopefully we are trying something new and stretching our spiritual muscles.

We are just a few weeks into to new year and this is the time of the year when we gear up for the Catholic Ministry Appeal. Next weekend, is the kick off. Many, if not all of us have gotten appeal envelopes in the mail. I would like to invite everyone to bring those envelopes to Mass next weekend as we make the appeal. Every year, each parish is assessed a portion of the Diocese budget. This year, our portion is less then last year by \$2,000.00. The total for all the parishes is \$89,000. That comes out to \$140.00 per household. Fr. Marty thinks that could be paid off in one month, but I just hold out hope that we get it paid by June 1st. May Saint Felix Cantalice, the patron saint of fundraising, pray for us.

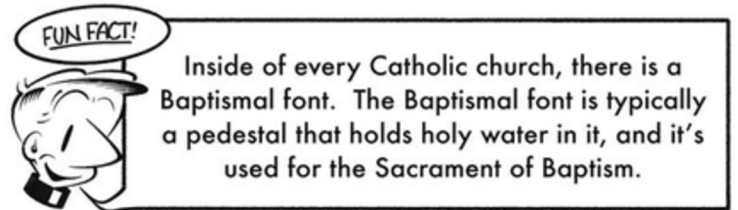
