Father Logsdon Logging in...

"If you knew the gift of God, and who was saying to you, 'give me a drink', you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." This seemingly simple statement of Jesus can become a guide for our spiritual life. Too often we are oblivious to the gift of God, or the one to ask, or how to ask. There is a desire in each one of us that can only be satisfied by God. The thirst that we have is a spiritual thirst. We try to satisfy this thirst with many things that can never fulfill the thirst. The encounter between the Samaritan woman and Jesus is a script for each one of us on our journey towards God. The shame of the woman can be seen in how we don't want anyone to know about our sinful behavior, but Jesus knows. She begins to recognize the significance of this encounter and shares it with others; something all of us are called to do. She becomes less significant as others discover their own relationship with Jesus. As we turn the corner for the second half of Lent, may we make a quick assessment of our journey and map out how we are called to move in the direction of a deeper, living relationship which flows and does not become stagnant.

Two important reminders need to be made as we approach the Easter season. First, and most important, is our intimate reception of our Lord in the Eucharist. It is the most important encounter in our lives. We invest a lot of time teaching our children the proper attitude and outward gestures, but as we get use to the process we can become "lazy". An act of reverence is offered as we approach (a bow of the head), if we receive in the hand, the dominant hand supports (under) the other hand. If you receive on the tongue, extend the tongue past the lips. People are welcomed to kneel to receive, but must be mindful of the people behind them where we do not have communion rails or kneelers.

The second issue is the dress code for Mass. While the weather becomes warmer, it does not excuse us from dressing properly for the wedding banquet of the Lord. That is a good image to keep in mind when getting ready to come to Mass. if you dress up more for a friend's wedding then for the wedding feast of the Lamb, who are you showing that you love more? Please prayerfully consider that our appearance at Mass is an exterior demonstration of our love for the one who gave us everything on the cross.
