What is Divine Mercy? A quick search on the Internet tells you that it is a catholic devotion that reveals God's infinite, unconditional, love, and forgiveness towards every person, especially in the context of sin and suffering. It is rooted in the 1930s revelations of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who received visions of Jesus showing his "merciful heart" and asking her to spread the message of his mercy in a world of need. This devotion was promoted by St. Pope John Paul the second, who was also Polish, and is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter. This is not a get out of jail free card, but a devotion that has been given to foster a deeper desire for God's mercy and a recognition of our sinful nature that needs Grace. One Catholic principle that we need to keep in mind is that grace builds on nature. If we cultivate our natural desire for God the grace will move us further along the path. Understanding that Divine Mercy has been given to us as an avenue on our path to holiness. "Jesus, I Trust in You."

I want to make a short appeal for people to give to our Catholic Ministry Campaign for the support of the Diocese. We are almost halfway to the goal and we want to get all the money raised by June 1st so that we can focus on our local needs. Our goal is \$89,000 for all four parishes, and we have about \$40,000 given, please use the envelopes in the pews and drop in the regular collection. The Pastorate staff is helping me make a list of the upkeep needs at all four parishes that people may want to donate to at the local level.

Our Easter celebrations were Uh-mazing. The music, the decorations, the help of ministers, and altar servers. Most importantly, I believe that God was praised by the many people that attended and were welcomed into our community. I will leave the photos up at all four churches, and if you see any of our new Catholics, make them feel extra welcomed. We are an Easter people, and Alleluia is our song.
