Our responsibility is to continue to pray for the unity of the Church and to call everyone who attends chapels of the SSPX to repent and return to full communion. If anyone has questions about this group or the penalties that have been applied, please contact Fr. Logsdon.

This weekend we're being visited by a missionary from the society of St Paul. They are missionaries originally founded to evangelize the people of North America. They have mission houses in several cities around the United States and one in Italy. They minister to non-Catholics and Catholics who have fallen away from the faith outside of the Catholic Churches walls.

They are working in eleven countries of Africa, (South Africa, Malawi, Botswana, Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, Central African Republic, The Gambia, Nigeria, Kenya, and Southern Sudan. They have over 140 seminarians in Nigeria.

Their missions in rural parts of Africa provide food and support for children. They run elementary schools to cater for the educational needs of children from poor families and assist young people with vocational training. They need funds to: 1) provide freshwater wells, and health care in rural communities; 2) Sponsoring seminarians, our future priests; 3) Supporting priests in the founding/building of new churches. - 1) Make a report to the Department of Child Services by calling (800) 800-5556.
- 2) Call Melanie Stone, Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- 3) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.
