Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

You will notice that the bulletin is different today. It is the same bulletin in Lebanon as in Frankfort. I think it will be a great help in developing the pastorate.

Part of the pastorate is choosing to not work as a silo. A silo parish is one in which everything is done all by itself. The hope is that parishes will benefit from working with one another.

A good example of not working as a silo was when both parishes cooperated and sponsored the movie at the drive-in. If it were up to either of the parishes alone (acting as a silo) it would have been cost prohibitive to rent out the entire drive-in theater. But with both parishes working together we could easily cut the cost in half and it seemed reasonable to rent the entire drive-in theater.

It is hoped that there will be many more examples in the future of both parishes benefiting from working together. For this reason it makes sense to combine the bulletins into one document.

Queridos feligreses,

Un buen ejemplo de no trabajar como silo fue cuando ambas parroquias cooperaron y patrocinaron la película en el camino. Si fuera a cualquiera de las parroquias solas (actuando como un silo) habría sido prohibitivo alquilar toda la unidad en el teatro. Pero con ambas parroquias trabajando juntas podríamos reducir fácilmente el costo a la mitad y parecía razonable alquilar todo el viaje en el teatro.

Se espera que haya muchos más ejemplos en el futuro de ambas parroquias que se benefician de trabajar juntas. Por esta razón tiene sentido combinar los boletines en un solo documento.

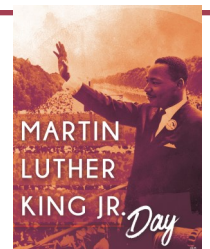
