

Today the Pastorate of St. Mary and St. Joseph wants to introduce a Lenten Journey based on the biblical readings for the season that will bring us to new life and freedom through forgiveness. Each Sunday of Lent some points for personal reflection will be offered; as well as discussion questions to use in family or in a small group. Finally, there will be concrete actions offered to express our turning back to the Lord. These reflections are offered as part of our Life's Journey to pray and reflect this holy season of Lent as a time of true forgiveness and healing which brings us new life.

Ash Wednesday: First Reading: Joel 2:12-18

The prophet Joel invites us to return to the Lord "with your whole heart".

Reflection Question: What is going on with my heart? Are there worries, or are there memories, that don't allow me to offer my whole heart to the Lord?

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:20-6:2

We are ambassadors for Christ called to be reconciled with God and ourselves. Now is the day of salvation.

<u>Reflection Question</u>: Is there something in my conscious that bothers me and makes me feel that I am not reconciled to God? Can I ask the Lord to save me today?

Gospel: Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18

The Gospel asks me to pray, fast, and practice charity as a response to God's love for me. Do I believe that God loves me just the way I am? Do I want to please him by returning his love?

<u>Discussion Question</u>: Do I see Lent as a time of self-imposed suffering to a demanding God or as a graced time of letting go of whatever holds me back from God's loving embrace?

Action:

- Spend these first few days reviewing my life so far this year. What do I need to attend to my own well-being and happiness?
- Lent might be a good time for a spiritual retreat and reflection.
- As part of my Lenten Journey, I might want to read some spiritual materials regarding Lent.
- I might want to make a sacrifice during Lent to contribute to the works of the parish.

<u>Prayer</u>

Grant, oh mighty God, through the yearly observances of holy Lent, that we may grow in understanding the riches hidden in Christ and imitate his love. Amen




