

Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

In our Strategic Plan there is tactic of evaluating our Holy Day schedule. This is largely due to several comments made in our surveys concerning Christmas Mass. There are some who would like there to be a Midnight Mass in both parishes. The strategic plan tactic is an effort to address not just the issue of Christmas masses, but the larger issue of all of the Holy Day Mass schedules.

I have formed a committee of six persons (three from each parish) to help me decided which direction to go on the Holy Day schedules. The first part of that committee's work is to gather some data from parishioners. That is why there is a short survey prior to all of the masses this weekend. It will only take a few seconds to answer the questions. Armed with this information hopefully the committee will know what direction to go with respect to the time of masses on Holy Days.

Rest assured, there is NO DESIRE AT ALL TO CHANGE ANY SUNDAY MASS TIMES. I think we have spent enough time on that issue. We are simply looking at the Holy Day Mass schedules at this point in time.

REPORT AN INCIDENT

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor.

Who Should Make Reports:

- Victims of child sexual abuse by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons with a suspicion that a child may be sexually abused by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons concerned about violations about our Code of Conduct regarding appropriate behavior with children by any person ministering on behalf of the Church.

How to Make a Report:

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement.
- Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement
- Call our Ethics Hotline 855-375-6796, or go to dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. OR
- Call Jeanne Lausten, Director of Human Resources at 765-269-4604.

Always contact local law enforcement of any incident of child abuse immediately.






