

Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners.

I have decided to make my wishes clear with respect to the location of funeral wakes.

While both St. Mary and St. Joseph can accommodate funeral wakes, under normal circumstances it usually works out better to have the wake at the funeral home. There are some Catholic churches which are set up to accommodate a funeral wake, but neither St. Mary nor St. Joseph really is.

At times when a wake takes place in the church, non-Catholics do not know how to respect the worship space. They have not been educated that the Blessed Sacrament is present in the church building and as such the worship space should be treated with great respect. For that reason it makes most sense to have the wake in a neutral location so that everyone is comfortable and our worship space is respected. While I don't expect people to be completely silent in the church building, running around and drinking a coke seems very inappropriate. However, it would be appropriate at the funeral

I am not saying that we will not accommodate a family if they desire to have a wake in the church, I am just saying that it would be better to have the wake in the funeral home.

There was no one particular situation which prompted me to write this article. I have just been thinking about it for quite some time.

He decidido dejar en claro mis deseos con respecto a la ubicación de los velatorios.

Si bien tanto St. Mary's como St. Joseph's pueden acomodar velatorios funerarios, en circunstancias normales generalmente funciona mejor tener el velatorio en la funeraria. Hay algunas iglesias católicas que están establecidas para acomodar un velatorio fúnebre, pero ni Santa María ni San José realmente lo son.

Por esa razón, tiene más sentido tener el velorio en un lugar neutral para que todos se sientan cómodos y se respete nuestro espacio de adoración. Si bien no espero que la gente esté completamente en silencio en el edificio de la iglesia, correr y beber una coca cola parece muy inapropiado. Sin embargo, sería apropiado en la funeraria.

No estoy diciendo que no acomodaremos a una familia si desean tener un velorio en la iglesia, solo estoy diciendo que sería mejor tener el velorio en la funeraria.

No hubo una situación particular que me impulsara a escribir este artículo. He estado pensando en ello durante bastante tiempo.


