## Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I wish to remind you that the Church expresses a preference for everyone to receive Holy Communion in a standing position.

The standing position is a position which emphasizes the resurrection of Jesus Christ because only a Resurrected body can stand upright. A dead body would be in a reclining position. Belief in the Resurrection is the reason we stand for the proclamation of the Gospel, because it is an alive Christ we proclaim when the Gospels are proclaimed.

The position of kneeling is used to express adoration. For example during Eucharistic Exposition kneeling is the preferred posture. Of course if a person is unable to kneel the Church understands that they cannot kneel, but the preference is to kneel at Exposition.

At the same time our Church has asked that if a person chooses to kneel while they receive Holy Communion, they should not be denied communion. It is for that reason that whether a person kneels or stands they should not ever be denied our Lord.

Sometimes a person thinks that receiving the Eucharist in a kneeling position is somehow more "holy" or better. It is not. I do not see how not following the Church's preference for reception of our Lord could ever be more "holy" or better.

So, if asked the preference of the Church is to stand to receive Holy Communion at Mass.



Estimados feligreses,

Deseo recordarles que la Iglesia expresa una preferencia por que todos reciban la Sagrada Comunion en posición de pie.

La posición de pie es una posición que enfatiza la resurrección de Jesucristo porque sólo un cuerpo resucitado puede mantenerse erguido. Un cadáver estaría en una posición reclinada. La creencia en la Resurrección es la razón por la que defendemos la proclamación del Evangelio, porque es un Cristo vivo que proclamamos cuando se proclaman los Evangelios.

La posición de arrodillarse se utiliza para expresar adoración. Por ejemplo, durante la Exposición Eucarística, arrodillarse es la postura preferida. Por supuesto, si una persona no puede arrodillarse, la iglesia entiende que no puede arrodillarse, pero la preferencia es arrodillarse en la Exposición.

Al mismo tiempo, nuestra iglesia ha pedido que si una persona elige arrodillarse mientras recibe la Sagrada Comunion, no se le debe negar la comunión. Es por esa razón que si una persona se arrodilla o se pone de pie, nunca se le debe negar a nuestro Señor.

A veces una persona piensa que recibir la Eucaristía en una posición arrodillada es de alguna manera más "santo" o mejor. No lo es. No veo cómo no seguir la preferencia de la iglesia por la recepción de nuestro Señor podría ser más "santo" o mejor.

Entonces, si se le pregunta, la preferencia de la iglesia es ponerse de pie para recibir la Sagrada Comunion en la Misa.

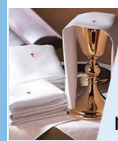

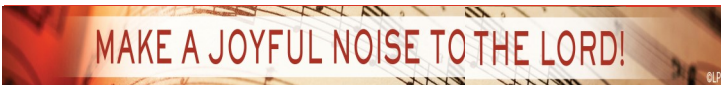
