Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

Recently the Vatican was asked to respond to the question: "If a Holy Day of Obligation in the Advent, Lent or Easter season falls on a Sunday and the Solemnity is transferred to Monday, does the obligation to attend Mass still apply?"

The Vatican answered in the affirmative.

This will result in a change in practice for the dioceses of the United States of America when, as occurs this year, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday, December 9. Previous instructions from the USCCB indicated that the obligation to attend Mass was abrogated in these instances. That is no longer the case; **the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is a Holy Day of Obligation this year, even though it is transferred to Monday.** This also means that funeral Masses are not permitted on Monday, December 9 this year.

Queridos feligreses,

Recientemente se le pidió al Vaticano que respondiera a la pregunta: "Si un Día Santo de Obligación en la temporada de Adviento, Cuaresma o Pascua cae en un domingo y la Solemnidad se traslada al lunes, ¿sigue aplicándose la obligación de asistir a misa?"

El Vaticano respondió afirmativamente.

Esto resultará en un cambio de práctica para las diócesis de los Estados Unidos de América cuando, como ocurre este año, la Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción se traslade al lunes 9 de diciembre. Instrucciones anteriores de la USCCB indicaron que la obligación de asistir a la misa se abrogaba en estos casos. Eso ya no es así; **la Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción es un Día Santo de Obligación este año, aunque se traslade al lunes.** Esto también significa que no se permiten misas funerarias el lunes 9 de diciembre de este año.

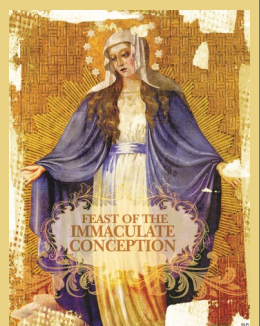

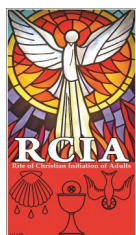

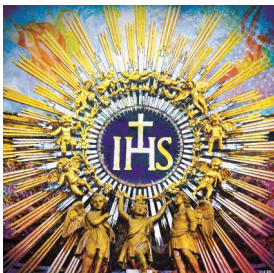
