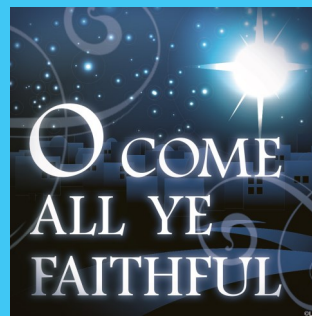

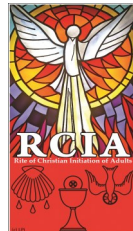

## Urgent Need!

### Help Make or Pack Rosaries for Soldiers

Rosaries for Soldiers began in October 2001 at St. Elizabeth Seton Parish, when a parishioner suggested that we make rosaries like her father had in WWII for our soldiers. We are now in our 24th year! Currently, we have 0 rosary makers at Seton, 1 in Columbus, IN and 1 in Logansport, IN. The Rosary Centurians, a homeschool/teen group in Indianapolis, has been contributing for many years. 25 others across the country contribute by mail.

Helpers at Seton help fold the prayer sheets and band them for packaging and shipping with the rosaries; package them with rosaries in plastic bags along with other materials; band holy cards; and learn quality control on rosaries received. This is a great opportunity for people with limited abilities, and most work can be done at home. Every 3-4 months boxes are packed for shipment to approximately 30 chaplains around the world.

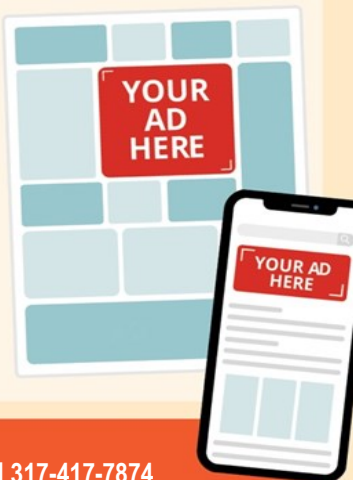

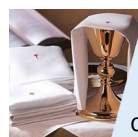
