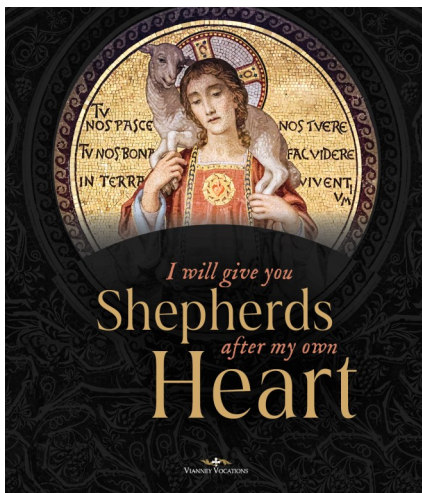

The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment.
