REPORT AN INCIDENT

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor.

Who Should Make Reports:

- Victims of child sexual abuse by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons with a suspicion that a child may be sexually abused by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons concerned about violations about our Code of Conduct regarding appropriate behavior with children by any person ministering on behalf of the Church.

How to Make a Report:

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement.
- Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement
- Call our Ethics Hotline 855-375-6796, or go to dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. OR
- Call Jeanne Lausten, Director of Human Resources at 765-269-4604.

Always contact local law enforcement of any incident of child abuse immediately.

- Personas preocupadas por violaciones de nuestro Código de Conducta en relación con el comportamiento apropiado con los niños por parte de cualquier persona que ejerza un ministerio en nombre de la Iglesia.

Cómo elaborar un informe:

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima de abuso sexual infantil en el pasado o en la actualidad por parte del clero (sacerdote o diácono), se le solicita que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente manera:

- Presente una denuncia ante los Servicios de Protección Infantil llamando al 800-800-5556 o a la policía local.
- Llame a Jackie Montrie, M.A., LMFT, LMHC, coordinadora de asistencia a víctimas de la Diócesis de Lafayette-in-Indiana, al (765) 464-4988.
- A partir de entonces, se llevará a cabo una investigación por parte de la Diócesis de Lafayette-in-Indiana o en su nombre.

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima de abuso sexual infantil en el pasado o en la actualidad por parte de alguien que trabaja en una parroquia o escuela de la Iglesia Católica Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette-in-Indiana (como una hermana o hermano religioso, empleado laico, voluntario laico, etc.), se le solicita que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente manera:

- Presente una denuncia ante los Servicios de Protección Infantil llamando al 800-800-5556 o a la policía local.
- Llame a nuestra línea directa de ética al 855-375-6796 o visite dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. O
- Llame a Jeanne Lausten, directora de Recursos Humanos, al 765-269-4604.

Comuníquese siempre con las autoridades locales de cualquier incidente de abuso infantil de inmediato.

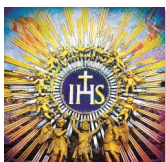
