The toolkit provides immediate steps that parishes and faith-based organizations can take to promote the safety and security of their members and to accompany and support immigrants who are detained or threatened by deportation. It includes:

- **Essential Know Your Rights information for immigrants.**
- **Emergency preparedness planning resources.**
- **Accompaniment and educational resources for staff and volunteers.**

Many people of faith and conscience are asking how they can help immigrants in this crisis — if you are one of them, I encourage you to please explore this resource for tips, ideas, and resources. This resource is aimed at Catholic audiences but is relevant for other communities of faith as well.

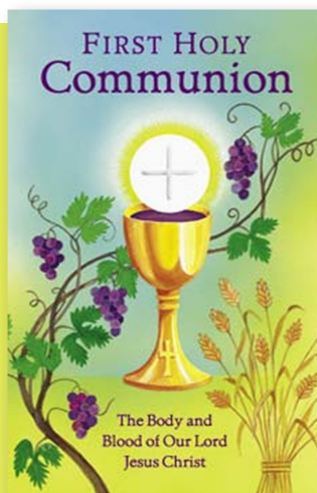
