The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus began in 1670, when Jesus appeared in visions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a Visitation nun, in France. Through these visions, He told her how He desired to be honored with the symbol of His Heart asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrong doing they had done, to frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart every June. It is celebrated on the third Friday after Pentecost. From this Solemnity came the First Friday observation. On every first Friday of each month we honor the precious Sacred Heart by participating in Mass. The Sacrament of Confession is requested and Holy Hour observance is practiced.

We can devote our hearts to His Sacred Heart everyday. There are many daily prayers that have been published for us to honor His Sacred Heart, that burns with desire for us to seek his infinite love and mercy. Let us be moved to love in return.

As the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart approaches, this year on Friday, June 12th, be mindful of the Novena of the Sacred Heart which begins on Wednesday, June 3.
