

Come hear Dan Schneider, Dr. Gerry Cvitanovich and Brandy Klingman, hosting a Town Hall Meeting on Tuesday, August 24th at 7:00 p.m. They will help us to recognize symptoms of drug abuse and impart critical advice to aid us in preventing family members and friends from falling prey to this deadly practice.

Gerry Cvitanovich, coroner of Jefferson Parish and an impassioned advocate for drug prevention.


Dan Schneider known as The Pharmacist for his award winning documentary series on NetFlix where he was relentless in pursuing the drug dealer who killed his son. Dan has built a nationwide movement, Tunnel of Hope, to end the Opioid pandemic that killed nearly a million since the death of his son in 1999.

Brandy Klingman is a licensed and skilled psychotherapist and the CEO of St. Christopher Addiction and Wellness Center and Legacy Behavioral Health Clinic. She started the first adolescent freestanding Mental Health and Substance Abuse Program in Louisiana. Brandy is a coveted speaker in high schools and has worked avidly at the national and state level on policy reform.

Dan Schneider Says: *Many of our children and grandchildren experiment with drugs. They are more susceptible than we were because of our greedy capitalistic companies like Purdue Pharma and the many marketers of drugs for this and that ailment. People start many times with Rx drugs from doctors which affect their brains and lead to addiction. We have young people without addictions who experiment with pills like Xanax, Percocet and Adderall, which they have seen and heard others take by Rx from Doctors. These profiteers are using this set up created by our pharmaceutical industry to sell look alike Rx pills which our children and grandchildren are falling victim to. One pill can kill, no second chance.*
