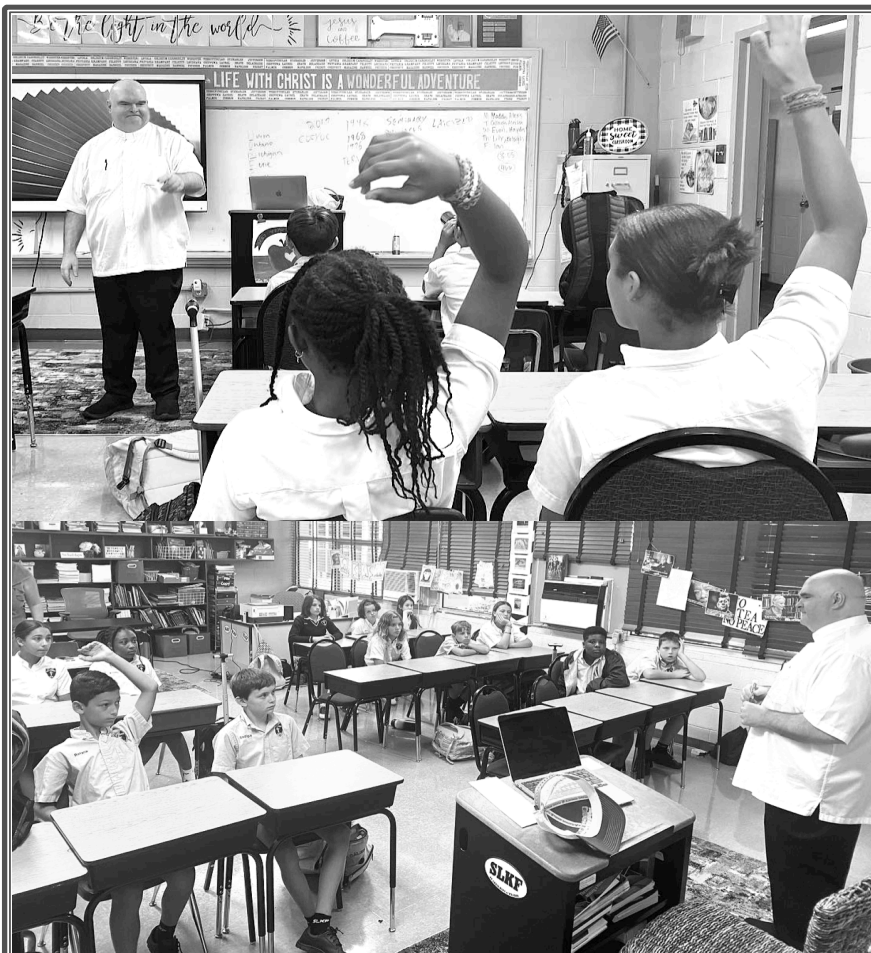




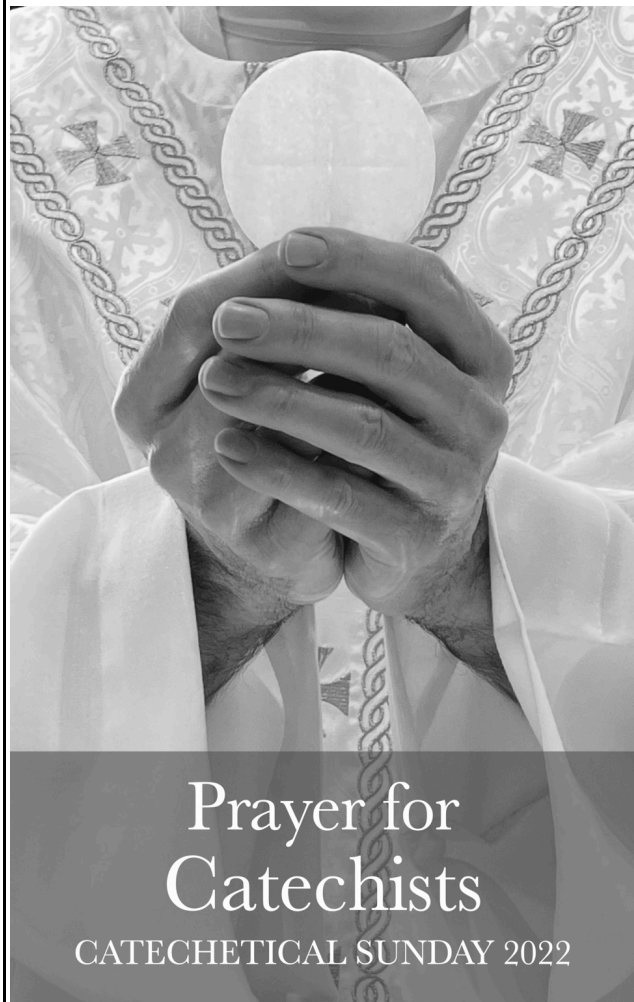

## ***SLKF 1<sup>ST</sup> COMMUNION PROGRAM***

If you are interested in enrolling your child in our 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation/1<sup>st</sup> Communion Program, please contact Becky in the Parish Office at 504-834-9977 or [bvillarrubia@slkfschool.com](mailto:bvillarrubia@slkfschool.com). Candidates must be at least 7 years old, registered in 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, and baptized. Our program consists of 8-9 mandatory Sunday classes spanning from September to April. Classes are held from 9am to 11:30am. The children will attend Mass at 9am and then move into classroom time with their CCD instructors. The cost of the program is \$75.



## ***SLKF CONFIRMATION PROGRAM***

If your high-school student is interested in becoming an SLKF Confirmation candidate, please contact the parish office. As per the Archdiocese of New Orleans, candidates must be at least 16 years old, registered as a junior in Catholic high school, have received 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion, and have gone through consecutive years of religious education / CCD classes prior to their training. Religious Education classes taken by students who do not attend catholic school, should be classes offered either in the church parish or in a Catholic school. The Archdiocese recognizes no other programs or schools for preparing your child's Religious Faith formation. SLKF's Confirmation Training Program consists of 6-8 mandatory Sunday morning classes that are held from September to February, 9am to 11:30am. Candidates will attend 9am Mass and then move into classroom time with their instructor. Registration fee is \$100. Classes will begin in September so it's not too late to register with SLKF today!
