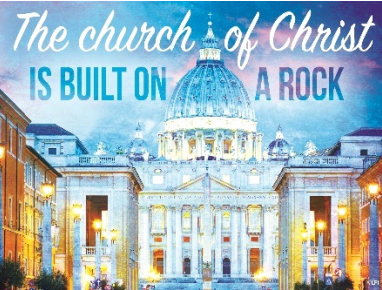

Dear Parishioners,
Authority seems to be the focus of today’s liturgy, especially the first reading and the Gospel. It is also clear from these readings is that we are not celebrating a merely human authority. As exercised among God’s people, earthly authority has heavenly roots.



Peter’s statement of faith that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, comes not from human knowledge, but through a revelation from God. As Jesus announces that Peter is the bearer of the keys of the kingdom, Peter is given the authority to bind and lose.

Authority in the Church is not arbitrary; it must be rooted in obedience to the Truth that is from God. The key to understanding authority among the followers of Jesus, is service. Attentiveness, and obedience to what God has revealed.
