- 2. Single intention: Weekday Masses (Mon Fri) at 6:30 am.
- 3. Parishioners: Sunday at 11:00 am, Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Thanksgiving, and one Mass of a Holy Day of Obligation. This is the only intention permitted on these days and times.
- 4. No intentions accepted for Good Friday, as Mass is not celebrated on that day.

If your intentions are for Multiple intention days, there is no need for you to come to the rectory. Place your intentions for these "Multiple" days along with your name, phone number and offering in an envelope marked 2020 Mass Intentions (Multi) and drop it in the collection basket . 
2019 Giving Tree Project sponsored by
