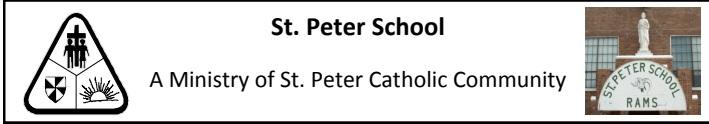

2. Single intention: Weekday Masses (Mon - Fri) at 6:30 am.

Please **do not include weekday single intentions** on this list.
