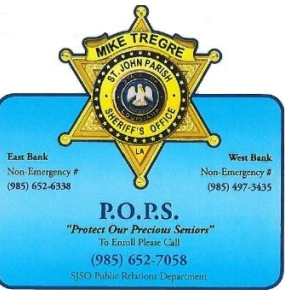

SUNDAY. We celebrate this day by remembering our baptismal call—to bring the Gospel to all!
