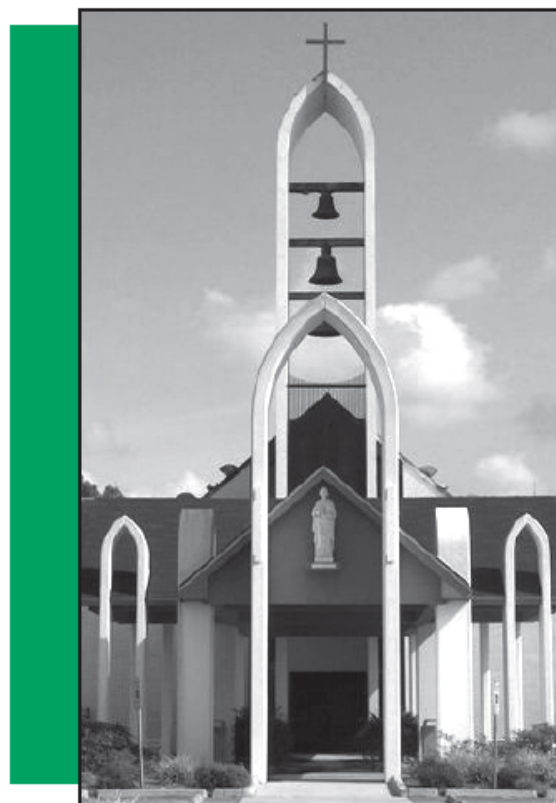
All couples planning to be married must call the parish office at least 6 months before their intended wedding date. Participation in a marriage preparation program is required.

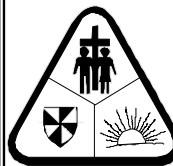

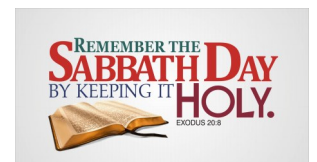

In today's Gospel we hear the story of the feeding of the five thousand. This story is found in all of the Gospel accounts of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Beginning this weekend until the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time (August 22) the Gospel will be from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. Chapter Six of John's Gospel is known as "The Bread of Life" discourse. Saint John devotes an entire chapter on Jesus as the Bread of Life—the Eucharist.

Then Jesus took the loaves, and when he had given thanks, he distributed them to those who were seated; so also the fish, as much as they wanted.



Today is **World Day for Grandparents and Elderly**. Pope Francis inaugurated this special day in honor of grandparents and the elderly in January after praying the angelus.
